t is once again soon time to start enjoying our favourite four wheeled feats of technical marvel. The pleasure of your ride is due to road quality, vehicle creature comforts, reliability and technical design features of its era.

As you know our Touring Inspection Program helps ensure reliability and safety of your pride and joy. It is STRONGLY recommended that all Club recognized vehicles get inspected each year. A current year inspection pass is also a REQUIRE-MENT for National events (TTY). Our program Club wide is healthy and has been steady over time; however, there is always room to see more vehicles at inspection events. The percentage of vehicles in the Club vs. those inspected can be improved.

In preparation for inspection check these simple things on your vehicle: lights, fluid levels, possible leaks, tire condition and pressure. Take it for a test drive. Notice unusual noises, steering, tracking, and braking. Become one with the machine. I might suggest either before or soon after inspection, drive your pride and joy like your daily driver – run a couple of tanks of gasoline through it over a few weeks. Most problems will likely show themselves or disappear. I suggest it may also perform better after somewhat regular use. Don't forget to bring your fire extinguisher and current insurance slip to inspection.



## Radio Town: The Doc Cruickshank Story

In 1926 Wingham, Ontario, self-described "tinkerer" Doc Cruickshank managed to build a working radio transmitter in his garage. Eventually blossoming into CKNX, one of Canada's most influential radio and TV broadcasters, that transmitter ushered in Canada's answer to the Grand Ole Opry. From The National Farm Radio Forum to the Saturday Night Barn Dance and The Circle 8 Ranch, Doc's programming reflected his stubborn belief in the power of radio to unite people and build community.



This newly commissioned country musical celebrates CKNX and its beloved founder, and features live performances of the music of Earl Heywood, the Ranch Boys, Ernie King, Cora Robertson and more.

Last year some of us participated in the trip to the Blyth Festival, and it was very well received, so we are planning on another trip to Blyth.

Some of you will certainly recall when CKNX radio was on the air, and of course, listening to the live performances of many celebrities from our past.
